- You can fill up the 10' x 10' area as you wish.
- **Tents will not be provided, you will need to bring your own.**
- There is no power/electricity.
- You are welcome to sell items at your table, but no food or beverages.
- As in past years Range Resources will be sponsoring the History and Heritage Area. Your organization will receive a donation for participating in the Festival (Must remain setup until 5:00 on July 9th). The donation checks will be mailed following the event.
